I. Key data on HPV and HPV-related cancers



Lebanon has a population of 2.12 million women ages 15 years and older who are at risk of developing cervical cancer. Current estimates indicate that every year 124 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer and 73 die from the disease. Cervical cancer ranks as the

10th most frequent cancer among women in Lebanon and the 8th most frequent cancer among women between 15 and 44 years of age. Data is not yet available on the HPV burden in the general population of Lebanon. However, in Western Asia, the region Lebanon belongs to, about 2.5% of women in the general population are estimated to harbour cervical HPV-16/18 infection at a given time, and 72.4% of invasive cervical cancers are attributed to HPVs 16 or 18.




